

HOLLY SCRAP! mija handmade



MATERIALS

- Holly Scrap! template
- Assorted fabric scraps at least 2½" x 2½"
- Double-sided, fusible interfacing
- Hot glue gun and glue sticks
- 1 mm braiding cord, cut into 10" lengths
- Pen for tracing template
- Wool felt balls
- Scissors



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Each Holly Scrap! ornament requires 2 pieces of scrap fabric and 1 piece of interfacing. Multiple ornaments can be traced onto and cut from large scraps or long strips for more efficient use of fabric.



NO - SEW ASSEMBLY

Assemble fabric scrap, interfacing and fabric scrap according to your interfacing instructions. Trace the Holly Scrap! template on the unit and cut out.

Apply a small strip of hot glue to the stem of the leaf approximately ¾" long. While hot, attach one end of the braiding cord and pinch the sides of the stem together to create a curved shape.

Make a second holly leaf, attaching the other end of the cord.

Apply hot glue to an outer edge of one holly stem. While hot, attach to the second holly stem.

Attach wool felt balls at the stem with more hot glue.

Hang your Holly Scrap! on the tree, use as a napkin ring or a gift tag. Share your version using #HollyScrap & #mijapatterns.
